WHAT IS RESYSTA?

Resysta is a wood-free material developed to provide the natural look and feel of wood with exceptional resistance to moisture and weather. It does not swell, splinter, crack or rot, and it does not require routine oiling.

DAILY CARE

- Remove loose dirt and debris with low-pressure water or a soft brush.
- For general cleaning, use a soft brush with water and mild soap as needed.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Suitable for outdoor environments, including areas exposed to saltwater and chlorine.
- Thoroughly clean at least once each year, removing food residue and other organic matter that can contribute to mildew staining.

Regular cleaning maintains the appearance and extends the life of the material.

STUBBORN STAINS

- Address spills promptly. For food, wine, oil or grease, clean with hot - not boiling - water and a brush.
- For persistent stains, use Resysta Cleaner RSC as directed.
- Apply the cleaner to the stain with a soft brush or cloth, allow it to work for a few minutes, then scrub gently.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Resysta Cleaner RSC is specially formulated for optimal results.

PROTECTIVE COATING + SEALER

- Resysta Sealer creates a protective barrier that helps keep dirt at the surface so it can be washed away more easily.
- For heavily used areas or where grease and staining are likely, Resysta recommends the clear protective coating RCC.
- RCC helps prevent deep penetration of dirt and stains and makes subsequent stain removal easier.
- Sealer or RCC may be reapplied as needed depending on use and exposure. Ask your Keystone representative for guidance.

SCRATCHES + REPAIR

- Stains and scratches can be repaired by gentle sanding and finish touch-up.
- Repair may include sanding consistently in one direction, reapplying the appropriate Resysta stain/color finish, allowing it to dry, then applying sealer in the same direction.
- For hospitality furniture, contact Keystone & Company before sanding, refinishing or performing a significant repair.

WHAT TO AVOID

- Do not use high-pressure water or steam cleaners.
- Do not use abrasive pads, steel wool or scouring agents.
- Do not use strong acids, alkalis, bleach or solvent-based cleaners.
- Avoid prolonged contact with strongly staining substances such as iodine, betadine or hair dye.
- Do not place hot items directly on the surface for long periods.
