AT A GLANCE



DAILY CARE

- Dust regularly with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.
- Wipe up spills immediately.
- Clean with a soft, slightly damp cloth and mild soap if needed.
- Dry thoroughly with a soft, clean cloth.
- Use coasters, placemats, and protective pads under décor and lamps.

Routine care prevents buildup and maintains the wood's natural beauty.

ENVIRONMENTAL CARE

- Maintain a consistent indoor environment.
Ideal humidity: 35–55% | Ideal temperature: 60–80°F
- Keep away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and HVAC vents.
- Sudden changes in temperature or humidity can cause wood to expand, contract, or crack.

A stable environment is key to long-lasting performance.

WHAT TO AVOID

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Harsh chemicals, ammonia, or abrasive cleaners. • Silicone-based polishes or waxes. • Excess moisture or standing water on surfaces. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct heat from dishes, cookware, or appliances. • Dragging heavy or sharp objects across surfaces. • Placing hot or wet items directly on the wood. |
